

## **CIL Pays Rs. 1705.42 Cr. Dividend for 08-09 Signs MoU for 2009-10**

**Kolkata 30<sup>th</sup> March 2009:** Coal India Limited has today paid dividend of Rs. 1705.42 Crores to Government of India for the year 2008 – 09. A cheque was handed over to Shri. C. Balakrishnan, Secretary Coal, Government of India by Shri Partha S. Bhattacharyya, Chairman, Coal India Ltd.

A memorandum of understanding (MoU) was also signed between Coal India Ltd. and Ministry of Coal, Government of India for the year 2009- 2010. The parameters for production of 430 million tones of coal would get a 'very good' rating while a production of 440 million tones will earn Coal India 'excellent' rating.
